BOARD MESSAGE

"To serve the greater Phoenix north valley by building community through musical performance and education, while enhancing music appreciation through artistically engaging concert experiences for audiences of all ages, and providing multi-generational musicians a place to enjoy the collective art of making music." NVSO Mission Statement

The Board met on June 15, 2013, to articulate goals for the upcoming years. These goals were established, based on one over-arching premise: **NVSO will never go into the "red" but will always have a balanced budget, and stay within our budget year to year.**

Accomplishments

This past year of the North Valley Symphony Orchestra (NVSO) saw a significant growth in the quality and reputation of our orchestra. The concert season was expanded from 3 to 4 concerts, with two additional concerts from the Youth and Symphonettes Orchestras.

NVSO established outreach groups to provide music in smaller settings. Beyond creating a community presence, these groups also produced unexpected revenue for NVSO.

NVSO was able to produce \$5,000 for the reserve fund, meeting a milestone in continuation of the 5 year goal of raising \$25,000 for said fund.

NVSO has maintained a strong relationship with the Paradise Valley School District and the North Phoenix Chamber of Commerce.

The Adult Orchestra has a membership of 74 and the Youth and Symphonettes has a membership of 42.

Board Membership

The present NVSO Board consists of: Kevin Kozacek, Musical Director; Dennis Dorch, Board President; Chad Kurtzman, Vice President; Cindy Kozacek, Board Secretary; Steve Thomasson, Treasurer; and Kristel Donaldson, Lewis Davis and Gail Jarick as Members-at-Large.

Meeting last Years Goals

The Board met on June 15, 2013, to articulate goals for the upcoming years. These goals were established, based on one over-arching premise: **NVSO will never go into the "red" but will always have a balanced budget, and stay within our budget year to year.**

A good measure on the progress of the orchestra is to evaluate the accomplishments of the year against the goals set in 2013.

• Goal: 1 year operational budget in 'savings' = \$25,000 (5 year goal) – we will begin working to accomplish this goal by putting ½ of each year's 'ending profit' into a protected fund

The Board has been able to set aside another \$5,000 this year (\$10,000 for the first two years). We are meeting this goal.

• Goal: Own our own timpani, bass drum and tubular bells = \$20,000 (3 year goal). We will accomplish this goal with specific fund raising.

Not yet accomplished

• Goal: Staffing – Paid administrator (2 year goal)

Not yet accomplished

Goal: Grant Applications – 2014 (2-5 year goal)

NVSO submitted 0 grant applications this past year. However, NVSO will be eligible to apply for an Arizona Arts Commission grant this coming year.

Goal: Average 750 audience members per concert (3 year goal)

Not yet accomplished, but good progress has been made.

• Goal: Reduce Adult Orch. Membership fee by ½ (3 year goal)

Not financially feasible yet

Goal: Grants = \$3,000 in 13-14 season; \$7,000 in 14-15 season; \$10,000 as 3-year goal.

We received no grants this past year.

• Goal: Sponsors = 1 concert sponsor per concert @\$4,000 13-14 season; 2 concert sponsors per concert @\$6,000 14-15 season; 2 concert sponsors per concert @\$8,000 15-16 season.

There were no concert sponsors this past year.

• Goal: Fund-raising = \$2,000 per season (3 year goal)

This goal was achieved through the use of outreach performances.

• Goal: Individual donor = \$7,500 13-14 season; \$10,000 14-15 season; \$12,500 15-16 season.

Although there were many individual donors this past year, NVSO has yet to attract the type of donors envisioned in this goal.

Goal: Repertoire Sponsor = \$100 per piece

This goal has not been achieved.

Music Director Report:

The second season of North Valley Symphony Orchestra was a resounding success! The group not only stepped up to a new level of artistic excellence, but the organization also increased our presence in the community through numerous outreach initiatives.

The adult orchestra additionally expanded the concert season to four concerts, which required not only a higher commitment level by the members, but additional administrative work by the board and all volunteer staff.

The opening concert "Journey's Fantastique" featured Berlioz's *Symphonie Fantastique*, which was narrated by North Phoenix Chamber of Commerce CEO Jason Bressler. Additionally, Gabrielle Lorenc, the winner of the Summerford Violin Concerto Competition from Spring of 2013, was featured as the soloist for Saint Saens's *Danse Macabre*. The narration of trhe Berlioz was well received by the audience, as it helped "tell the story" as it was played. Ms. Lorenc was flawless in her performance, and at age 15, is a delight to work with.

The holiday concert titled "Holiday Toys" featured pieces that were associated with the toys of the season, including *The Toy Symphony*, which is typically attributed to Haydn or Mozart. The concert also included a number of pieces performed by "The Maestros of Swing," which was a group created from within the NVSO membership as an additional outlet for musical appreciation and performance. In January 2014, "The Maestros of Swing" voted to continue their group outside the purview of NVSO, and the NVSO Board and I sincerely wish them well in their endeavor.

The March concert "Tchaik Five" was in my estimation a turning point for our organization. Though the group had previously performed major classical, symphonic works, this was somewhat a "rite of passage" to perform one of the "war-horse" symphonies, Tchaikovsky's *Symphony #5*. I was very pleased with this performance, and the level of artistic expression that we achieved at this concert. The Vanhal *Kontrabasse Concerto* was additionally performed at the concert, featuring regional bassist Christopher Finet, who simply stunned the audience with his virtuosity on his instrument. All said, this was a premier concert that moved the orchestra forward into a new arena.

Likewise, our May 2014 concert titled "American Masterpieces" featured two very difficult and artistically challenging pieces, Copland's *Appalachian Spring Suite*, and Hanson's *Symphony #2, The Romantic*. These pieces capped off a concert season that was challenging for the musicians, as well as being inviting and interesting for the audience.

NVSO had an unexpected opportunity to participate in the annual convention for Banfield Pets, which was held in Scottsdale. A small component of the orchestra played two pieces by

request of the CEO of that organization. The back-stage "studio" orchestra performance opportunity was thoroughly enjoyed by the 20 NVSO musicians who were able to participate.

The string and woodwind ensembles from within NVSO also performed numerous times within the community, at luncheons, golf events, weddings, nursing home concerts, and school educational programs. Through these outreach events, the groups not only raised additional funds for the organization, but also served a tremendous service to our community and local schools.

The youth program within NVSO was also a wonderful highlight of the 2013-14 season. The Youth Orchestra opened for every Adult Orchestra concert, which highlights the multigenerational approach to our organization throughout the concert season. The Symphonettes also entertained in the lobby during intermission at each of the four concerts. The Youth Orchestra and Symphonettes also presented two combined concerts at the end of each semester at Resurrection Church in Scottsdale. The opportunity for talented valley youth to rehearse and perform in an orchestra that is commensurate with a typical district honor orchestra throughout the year is a program that will benefit not only NVSO as a feeder type program for exceptional musicians in the Adult Orchestra, but also help nurture leaders that participate in their local school programs.

The second annual Summerford Violin Concert Competition was held during April, and the winner was Frank Islas, Jr. Mr. Isla performed the Bach *Violin Concerto in A Minor* at the May concerts. It is with most sincere thanks that we recognize Jodi Summerford for handcrafting a violin each year for the winner of this competition. The competition is a wonderful opportunity for the young musicians of the organization.

Most of all, I am awed at the tremendous talent and dedication shown by all the members of NVSO, as well as the leadership team on the Artistic Staff and Board of Directors. NVSO is making a positive statement to our community through music, and I am proud and honored to be the leader of the organization.
